

U.S. L-Code Suggestions/Definitions for Prosthetic Knees & Joints

This form is provided as a reference for you to fill in and save in your patient's file. The L-Codes listed below are suggestions based on our knowledge of this product. It is the responsibility of the prosthetist to use correct coding when submitting information to Medicare and private insurance companies.

Impulse® Ankle	L5986	All lower extremity prostheses, multi-axial rotation unit ("MCP" or equal)
Stabilized Knee	L5812	Addition, endoskeletal knee-shin system, single axis, friction swing and stance phase control (safety knee)
Stabilized Knee with extension assist	L5812	Addition, endoskeletal knee-shin system, single axis, friction swing and stance phase control (safety knee)
	L5850	Addition, endoskeletal system, <u>above knee or hip disarticulation</u> , knee extension assist
GeoFlex Knee	L5611	Addition to lower extremity, endoskeletal system, <u>above knee-knee disarticulation</u> , 4 bar linkage, with friction swing phase control
	L5845	Addition, endoskeletal knee-shin system, stance flexion feature, adjustable
	L5850	Addition, endoskeletal system, <u>above knee or hip disarticulation</u> , knee extension assist
GeoLite Knee	L5611	Addition to lower extremity, endoskeletal system, <u>above knee-knee disarticulation</u> , 4 bar linkage, with friction swing phase control
	L5850	Addition, endoskeletal system, <u>above knee or hip disarticulation</u> , knee extension assist
